

The Barns Green Half Marathon

A Sussex Grand Prix Event & Sussex Championships

Sunday 30th October 2011 Start time 11:00 am.



Barns Green village is 5 miles south-west of Horsham in West Sussex. The course starts at the Village Hall, postcode RH13 0PT and is double looped along quiet country lanes. Not suitable for wheelchair entrants. Chip to Chip timing. Medals to all finishers. A programme will also be included in the entry fee.

The race takes place on closed roads with five water stations on the course and bottled water at the finish. Parking, changing facilities, secure baggage storage and level 2 first aid provision will be provided. Hot and cold refreshments and massage are also available. The race will close at 1.45 pm (when the road closure order ends) and runners still on the course after this time do so at their own risk. The Sussex Championships are open to county qualified runners having an England Athletics competition licence and to teams from clubs affiliated to the County Association.
